Q: Does every itinerary have land programming?

A: Yes, every itinerary will now have land programming, whether that be before or after the cruise with an AzAmazing Journey, Land Journey, or Stay Local or during the cruise with an Overnight Experience. In total, we have 1700+ offerings, which means a prospect guest has 1700+ opportunities to purchase a land program.

Q: Who is operating the programs?

A: We are collaborating with independent, local experts such as Micato Safaris, Cox & Kings, Abercrombie & Kent, Aloschi Bros, COLTUR Peru, and Furlong Incoming. Cox & Kings has developed over 75% of our pre and post land programming. All programs operated by Cox & Kings are unique to Azamara and cannot be found elsewhere.

Q: What is an AzAmazing Journey?

A: AzAmazing Journeys occur before or after the cruise. These carefully curated programs consist of small, intimate group led by expert guides. These experiences last three to six days, with the exception of long train journeys. Guests will fully dive into local culture through upclose explanations and interactive experiences with local independent specialists including historians, professors and connoisseurs. These journeys feature AzAmazing moments, which are off-the-beaten-path experiences, and accommodations in the world's most breathtaking corners, from five-star hotels and castles to boutique inns, luxury lodges, and glamping experiences.

Q: What is a Land Journey?

A: Land journeys occur before or after the cruise. These programs allow guests to see cities from different vantage points and offers a specialized travel experience that reveals both the hidden gems and iconic landmarks of a variety of captivating destinations. Land Journeys last anywhere from three to six-nights, offer a wider group size filled with like-minded travel enthusiasts and includes accommodations from four to five-star hotels to boutique inns, luxury lodges and more. Visitors can be a part of intensive explorations of cities such as Athens, Greece, and experience family-run vineyards and spend a special evening under the roof of the historic Benizelou Mansion in the metropolis' less-visited.

Q: What is a Stay Local?

A: Previously known as "City Stays," this programming permits cruisers, who have less time to explore but still want to experience a destination, the opportunity to immerse themselves in the local life of a particular city. These experiences offer an intensive crash-course in the city of embarkation or disembarkation, either pre- or post-cruise, taking guest far beyond typical city highlights and immersing them in local life.

Q. Can you buy just a land program?

A. No. Currently, all land programs must be purchased in conjunction with an Azamara voyage. Guests also have the option to add a land program to an existing booking, if available.

Q. Can you still buy a cruise with flights and no land at all?

A. Yes, our land programs are optional add-ons designed to extend your exploration beyond the cruise.

Q: Are these packages only available for new reservations?

A: No. Since the package is technically an Add-on, you can simply add-on to any existing reservation. You can do this under "Land Packages" via Espresso or calling the call center.
